

# Milestones

## the first 15 years of IFPB



**2001**

The Fellowship of Reconciliation (FOR) sends its first Interfaith Peace-Builders delegation just 3 months after the Second Intifada starts.

**2005**

A partnership delegation with FOR's Creating a Culture of Peace sends nonviolence trainers from the US to learn from Palestinian and Israeli activists, building IFPB's vision of collaborative work through partnerships.



**2008**

IFPB partners with AFSC's Third World Coalition to send 14 community leaders and organizers on our first People of Color Delegation. The delegation is the 3rd of 12 partnership delegations with AFSC to date.



**2002-2004**

IFPB's 4th delegation is among the first foreign groups to enter Jenin Refugee Camp after the Israeli massacre there. By 2004, IFPB has led 11 formative delegations and our first 100 delegates to Palestine/Israel. We inaugurate our vision of collaborative work through partnership delegations and hire our first Education and Advocacy Coordinator - signaling a commitment to supporting delegates and maximizing their advocacy efforts.



**2006**

IFPB becomes an independent organization and survives our first year with FOR seeding and the generosity of new donors. The enduring commitment of IFPB's delegates and donors ensures that the work continues and grows!
